Thomas Wilcock died from TB on 6th February aged 21

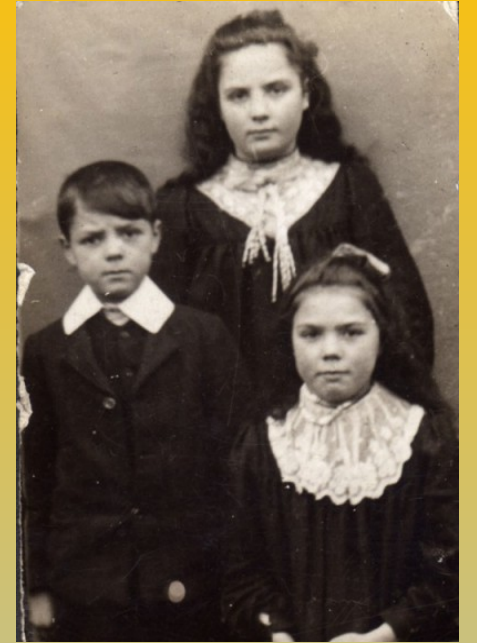
