Will Davies' life

Year of birth: 1888

Medals awarded: Victory and British War medal

Country of cemetery: Belgium

Biography details: Will Davies was born in Northop Hall in 1888, the same year that his mother died in.

Regiment: 15 BTN Royal Welsh Flintshire



Will Davies in the World War

Will Davies lived in Pentre Moch, Northop Hall before the war. Once he joined up, Will Davies battled hard. He thought he had to fight for his friends. His mother and father told him he could go to War when he was 18. Will Davies fought bravely in World War One.

He trained hard over and over. He didn't stop training to get ready for the dreadful War.

Will Davies battled hard and he did not give up. It was very scary fighting in the World War. He was awarded the Victory Medal and British war Medal



His dreadful death

He was killed in action by a rifle in action in Dixmude, his family was horrified. He is buried in Cement House Cemetery near Ypres, France. He is also named on his family Gravestone in Northop.
