Jonathon Roberts had a wife called Mary aged 45, he had a Dad called Jonathon and a Mum called Mary. He lived in Fern Bank, Northop Hall.

FAMILY



Jonathon Roberts was 19 years old when he died of horrific wounds. He died on the 5th of August in 1916.

HIS GRAVE



His body was buried in Egypt in 1916 at the Kantara War Memorial.

JONATHON ROBERTS WAR MEDALS



Jonathon Roberts was awarded the Victory Medal and the British War Medal. He was awarded these medals because of all the time he served in the war.
