Joseph.E.Dodd fought in World War 1.

He was in the Royal West Surrey Regiment.

He got the Victory and British War medals. He was a gunner,

Number 22099.

WHEN WAS HE BORN?

Joseph.E.Dodd was born in 1898.

WHERE DID HE LIVE?

He lived in Millfield House, Northop Hall.

He was living in the house in the 1901 census.

It was the house of his widowed grandmother.

WHEN DID HE DIE?

He was killed in the battle
of the Somme in France.

He died on 24th February 1917, he was only 19 when
he died.
