Edgar was buried in the Fouburg-d'Anniens cemetery, in the western part of Arras.

FACT:

The medals that Edgar was awarded were the Victory and British War medals ,which everyone who fought was awarded.

He lived in Connah's Quay, his house number was 287, Highway Street.
